The 2020-2021 school year will begin on September 12th, and there are a lot of important information to share with you:

- 1) As required by the provincial government, all schools are closed to the public on weekends. Therefore, our teaching will be all online for this school year.
- 2) Our 14 Chinese classes and 3 Math classes are open for enrollment, and all teachers are ready for online teaching. - 4) For your safety, we will provide masks/hand sanitizer and keep social distance at 744 Jackson during the onsite registration or issuing the textbooks.
- 5) The model of the online classroom is basically the same as the last year. It will be video meeting for the majority of the time and pre-recorded videos as the supplement.
